

# COLLEGE CREDIT/UNITS

## Math Perspectives Courses and Institutes

College credit is available for several of the Math Perspectives Institutes/Courses. Arrangements have been made as a courtesy to participants. College credit, where offered, is available on an **optional** basis. Tuition for college credit is **extra** and not included in the course fee.

Credits vary depending upon the institution offering the credit. For example, most universities offer **units of credit** for courses. Units of credit are usually acceptable as applying towards pay increases and professional development credit. However, they usually will not apply as credit towards advanced degrees. Participants are encouraged to check with their local districts, state, or university advisor to determine if the credit offered may be used for the purpose for which it is intended.

Tuition: Fee is \$75 per semester **unit of credit**.

Assignment: Attend all class sessions and participate in investigations and discussions. Complete all reading assignments. Turn in any written assignments.

*Grading System:* Credit/No Credit. Work must equal “B” work.

*Enrollment:* To be conducted the first day of the course.

*Comments:* This credit is post baccalaureate credit and in most cases can be applied as credit towards re-certification, professional development requirements and for salary increases. This credit is usually not accepted for credit towards postgraduate degrees.
