This course is open to teachers of grades K-2 mathematics, district math coordinators, math coaches and teacher-leaders from any school or district.

Course Description

During this two-day course, teachers learn to help students acquire competence in computation using visual models and number relationships to build number sense and to develop numerically powerful strategies that make sense to students. Students work with numbers using strategies that are simple, yet meaningful and powerful. Teachers see these methods modeled as they observe children solving problems during Number Talks. Course time is also devoted to helping teachers strengthen their own understanding of mathematics.
